Durango's new Hospice of Mercy Residence is a place for compassionate, end-of-life care. The philosophy of the residence is to transform the experience and care of the dying in a home-like environment of beauty, trust, comfort, peace, and support for family members, loved ones, and caregivers. The facility, set to open in the spring 2017, is the first of its kind in Southwest Colorado.

A continuum of care

Hospice of Mercy has provided compassionate hospital- and home-based hospice care in the community for over 30 years. Hospice staff provide a continuum of support that is tailored to meet the individual goals and needs of patients and families. The new hospice residence, contiguous to Mercy Regional Medical Center, will offer the option of acute, inpatient hospice care during this profound point in life. Proximity to the hospital benefits residents, families, and staff by providing convenient access to hospital-based services and amenities.

A closer look at home:

- A unique, home-like environment
- Expected completion: Spring of 2017
- Facility size: 11,000 square feet
- Site: 1.3 acres, adjoining the ground level of Mercy Regional Medical Center
- Eight large, private patient rooms with attached patios and in-room accommodations for families
- Guest space, including community kitchen and common space (meditation and "great" rooms)
- Landscaped memorial gardens decorated with sculptures, water features, seating, and more
- Designated parking for guests
